GOVERNMENT WORK FOR THE WORKERS

Secretary Wilson Reviews Operations of Labor Department—Mediation and Conciliation.

Washington, December 13.—Secretary Wilson, of the department of labor, in his annual report, submitted today, expressed the conviction that had the owners of the mine properties in the California copper region and the Colorado coal fields dealt with the strike situations in their own way, "had they been on the ground and personally in charge, there is reason to believe that no strike would have occurred."

"Whatever may have been the responsibility of the workers for the strike and its incidents," said Secretary Wilson, "the labor management cannot be wholly acquitted, and upon the elementary principle of agency, as sound in morals as in law, ultimate responsibility must rest upon the owners."

Primarily, Secretary Wilson's report is devoted to a review of the labor disputes the department has successfully mediated during the last year, and the defense at some length the principles upon which the department has acted.

Mediation and Conciliation. Of the mediation and conciliation work, the report says: "Of all the functions of the department of labor which it is yet possible to administer, this one may be reasonably regarded the most important. Suggesting with reference to la-

bor disputes a development of diplomatic in the department of labor, analogous to those in the department of state with reference to international disputes, it points to a federal administrative agency for promoting and fostering industrial peace, and a peace of the warlike order, but one of mutual benefit and good will.

"Primarily the department of labor is interested in the department of labor, the interests of the wage earners of the United States. Such is its duty under the law of its creation, the first section of which charges it with responsibility for the general welfare, while the eighth makes this responsibility specific as to labor disputes.

"But though the department of labor represents primarily the wage-earning interests in labor disputes, it is not to make its representation similar in character to that of the department of state, which, while representing the interests of this country in disputes between it and other countries, does so with fairness toward all countries. Accordingly the policy of the department of labor, though it executes its mediation and conciliation functions as the governmental representative of wage-earning interests, is to do so without favoritism or prejudice, but with fairness to every interest concerned.

Distribution of Wage-Earners. Mr. Wilson then discusses the distribution of wage-earners, saying: "The United States cannot be served by mediation of labor disputes, if it is not first made possible by affirmative measures for modifying it, without wholly obviating the industrial maladjustments that give rise to disputes must be undertaken as well. This purpose legislation is necessary. Pending such legislation, however, the department is utilizing its special powers as far as circumstances permit by availing itself of the services of the division of information in the bureau of immigration. This division of that bureau has been specifically empowered by congress to promote a beneficial distribution of immigrants, and to this end it has been directed to make a study of the conditions in the department of labor, charged, as this department is, with promoting the welfare of the wage-earners of the United States, that function as having been so far inferentially enlarged as to include citizens within the scope of its extended benefits. This department, therefore, through the division of information, entered upon plans of work for improving the opportunities of the wage-earners of the United States, whether citizens or aliens, for profitable employment.
