With Przemyśl Captured

**IT'S PREDICTED AUSTRIA
WILL BE SEEKING PEACE
IN A VERY SHORT WHILE**

Nearly 120,000 Austrian Soldiers Surrendered to the Russians at Przemyśl—The Men Were Reduced to Eating Moss and Gnawing Leather—Capture of Przemyśl Likened to Fall of Metz.

London, March 23.—Reuter's correspondent at Kiev, Russia, says that 4,000 prisoners, mostly from Przemyśl, have arrived there. "They gave a pitiable description of the starving condition of the garrison."

trenches. They ate moss and gnawed at the straps of their equipment to keep themselves alive."

London, March 23.—The size of the garrison at Przemysl and the number of men who surrendered to the Russians greatly exceed all estimates. According to Petrograd dispatches the garrison originally consisted of 178,000 men, of whom 40,000 were killed.

A blizzard, which has interfered with the telegraphic service, prevents details of the surrender from coming through, but Lemberg reports that

seven days prior to the fall of the fortress the people of the town had nothing to eat and the Russians, who took in large supplies of provisions, were welcomed as liberators.

Dispatches from Lemberg also state that 15,000 persons were found suffering from typhus or cholera and that the work of disinfecting the place is being undertaken energetically. The
