

THE SENATE PAVES THE WAY. The senate has by almost unanimous vote passed the appropriations bill, reduc-ing the amount of the aggregate house ap-proprlation so as to bring the expenditures

of the state within the limit of the state's income for the next two years.

Had the bouse provided the revenue to meet its appropriations the senate would not only have accepted the full appropriations the nose, but more than that, if would no doubt have gone further by agreeing to vote the additional amount required to meet the growing expenses of the state's public institutions.

The house tax bill reached the senate yesterday, and it is to be hoped that the combined wisdom of that body will so nex-fect this measure as to enable it to increase the revenue of the state to an amount that will not put the state to an amount that will not put the state institutions on a starvation basis. The senate undoubtedly did the right thing in reducing the appropriations bill to the basis of the state's revenue. The house undoubtedly did the wrong thing in medium por prevision to meet the expenditures authorized in its appropriations bill.






